The training for Belarus H2020 NCPs is part of the awareness raising campaign on Belarus national network of H2020 NCPs structure, efficiency and services organized in March – July 2016 within the EU-funded IncoNet EaP project.

- Officially nominated NCPs, their assistants and candidates for NCP position with a focus on newcomers
- Limited number of young researchers interested in cooperation with EU (depending on availability of seats)

Requirements to participants:

- 1) Please, do the homework and come to the training with a draft profile according to one of the 3 EEN templates – Technology Offer (TO), Business Offer (BO) or R&D Request (RD). The draft profile should be developed in line with the Profile Drafting Guidelines, http://ictt.by/Docs/manuals/2015-07-27_01/15-04-10_profile_drafting_guidelines_final.pdf. You will find some examples of profiles in the enclosed note.
During the training, the profile will be further developed, fine-tuned and, ideally, uploaded in the EEN system.

Goals:

- To improve the quality of the Belarusian NCPs' services related to partner search
- To present the variety of partner search e-tools supported by the EC (CORDIS, EURAXESS, Idealist and other thematic PS services, as well as EEN)
- To train NCPs how to practically work with the most popular of them, including EEN, Idealist and CORDIS
- To stimulate sharing of experience on using PS tools between more and less experienced NCPs.

Expected outcomes: Improved skills of NCPs in developing an effective and attractive profile and practical using of the most popular PS tools.
